Prof. Dr. Rudin Domi, finished studies in Faculty of Medicine, University of Tirana, in 1998. During 1999-2003 he finished his residency in Anesthesiology and Intensive Care Medicine in Tirana, Albania. He served as Consultant Anesthesiologist-Intensivist close Service of Anesthesiology and Intensive Care Medicine in “Mother Teresa” University Hospital Center in Tirana, Albania. During the period 2003-2004 he got the title “Master in Pharmacology”. In 2010 Prof. Domi got his PhD and in 2014 he became Associated Professor in Anesthesiology and Intensive Care Medicine. Prof. Domi became Professor in 2019.

Prof. Domi is full time professor in Service of Anesthesiology and Intensive Care Medicine, University of Medicine in Tirana, Albania.

Prof. Dr. Rudin Domi is author and co-author of 35 articles and 128 oral posters and lectures in Albania and abroad. Prof. Dr. Rudin Domi served as Editorial Member in several journals, and as a reviewer as well. Prof. Dr. Domi is Albanian Council Member in ESAIC, Albanian NASC representative, board member of Albanian Society of Anesthesiologists and Intensivists. His clinical expertise is focused on organ protection during anesthesia, intensive care medicine, anesthesia in adrenal gland surgery, cardiac anesthesia, neurosurgery, pediatric neuroanesthesia, and liver/kidney transplantation.
