Dr. Viviane Nasr is a Senior Associate in Cardiac Anesthesia at Boston Children's Hospital and an Associate Professor of Anaesthesia at Harvard Medical School. She is the Chief of Cardiac Anesthesia at Boston Children's Hospital. Her work is mostly related to patients with congenital heart disease and the perioperative risk assessment of pediatric patients. She has written more than 100 publications, textbook chapters and a handbook on pediatric cardiac anesthesia. In addition to her active academic career, she created and leads the Faculty Development Program at the Department of Anesthesiology, Critical Care and Pain Medicine at Boston Children's and is the Vice President of the Congenital Cardiac Anesthesia Society (CCAS).
