Role of Analgesic Adjuvants in Severe Burn Injury in Children: Timing and Precision

Learning Objectives:

1. Multimodal, multispecialty, opioid-sparing remains the analgesic approach for severe burn injuries in children.
2. Increasing evidence has shown the role of adjuvants, both pharmacotherapy and non-pharmacotherapy, in decreasing opioid usage with its side effects.
3. For this talk, I will:
 - Highlight the impact of timely and precise prescription of pharmacotherapy adjuvants to target the minimum essential-customized analgesic requirement of a child with severe burn injury,
 - Highlight the value of non-pharmacotherapy in easing the journey to recovery and developing a coping mechanism for a traumatic severe burn injury,
 - Integrate pharmacotherapy and non-pharmacotherapy in managing pain during the different phases of burn injury in children.
